LEOMINSTER ---John "Jack" B. LaClair, 85 years old, of Leominster, died Friday, October 12, 2018 in HealthAlliance-Leominster Hospital. In recent years he loved his daily morning coffee spent at Fatboy's and Mario's; his afternoon coffee at Dunkin Donuts on Main Street. He will forever be remembered for his wit and comedic genius.
